

## **Dental Hygiene Admissions - FAQs**

### **How do I keep track of my hours, and what information do I need for the application?**

You can track your hours using any method you prefer, such as an Excel spreadsheet. Be sure to record the following information: where you shadowed, the practice's contact information, the dates you shadowed, the total hours, and a brief description of the experience.

### **Where can I complete community service hours, and what counts as leadership?**

You can complete community service hours at various places, such as local non-profits, hospitals, schools, community centers, or dental clinics offering volunteering opportunities. Leadership can include roles like leading a team or project, holding an office in a student organization, coordinating events, or mentoring others.

### **Who can I choose for my letters of recommendation?**

We require one letter from a dental professional, such as a dentist you've shadowed or worked with, and one from an academic professional, like a professor or instructor who can speak to your academic abilities and potential. It's best to select individuals who know you well and can provide a detailed and positive account of your skills and experiences.

### **What is the personal character statement?**

The personal character statement is a reflection of your personal story and exploration of the field of dentistry. It's an opportunity to share your unique journey, motivations, and experiences. Dig deep and be creative – don't just say what you think we want to hear! Highlight what truly inspires you about dentistry and how your experiences have shaped your desire to pursue this career.

### **How recent do my experiences need to be?**

Ideally, your experiences should be recent, within the last few years, to reflect your current interests and skills. However, significant experiences that occurred earlier but had a profound impact on your decision to pursue dentistry can also be valuable to include.

### **When do my experiences need to be completed?**

Your experiences should be completed at the time you submit your application. You cannot go back later and add additional experiences or hours.
