What is the AEP?

The AEP is an intense ten-week summer program that provides students with the opportunity to prepare for the DAT, enhance their dental school application and begin the journey toward a career in the dental profession.

Who Can Benefit?

The AEP is committed to partnering with students from underrepresented, rural, and disadvantaged backgrounds who are motivated to develop and expand their skills, knowledge, and understanding regarding applying to and succeeding in dental school.

When do I Apply?

It is strongly encouraged that students have completed 90 hours of college credit at the time of entry into the AEP and completed courses in college algebra, biology, chemistry, and organic chemistry.

2018 AEP Course Dates

Online Coursework: May 16th – July 25th Onsite weeks: June 3rd – 8th and July 23rd – 26th

Accepted students in the AEP must commit to the following:

- Making self-available for at least 30 hours per week during the online course components, including during live online sessions three scheduled times per week.
- Taking the DAT in August, 2018 at student's own expense
- Providing own travel to and from Kansas City for the on campus sessions
