DDS SCHOLARSHIPS

Dental Academic Scholar Award

\$5,000-\$15,000

Established to recognize the top students within each dental class. Academic performance and professional and civic involvement are strongly considered for this one-time award.

Dean's Non-Resident Award (Renewable)

Awarded to select non-resident students who will contribute to excellence in our community. The award waives either 50%, 75% or 100% of the non-resident fee differential for students and is renewable on a yearly basis by maintaining a 3.0 grade point average.

Diversifying the Dental Profession Scholarship

\$5,000-\$30,000 (Renewable)

Established for dental students who will actively contribute to cultural diversity within our education and patient environment. We believe a culturally diverse student body enhances the educational opportunities for our students. It also prepares students to become competent practitioners who understand the needs of our community and underserved patient populations.

Chancellors' Minority Non-Resident Award (Renewable)

Automatically awarded to newly enrolled non-resident students who identify themselves on the UMKC admissions application as African-American, Hispanic, or Native American. The award waives the non-resident fee differential for students and is renewable on a yearly basis by maintaining a 3.0 grade point average.

Diversity in Dentistry Scholars

\$20,000

Partnership established to support the growth of a culturally diverse student body and dental profession. One-time award.

Arkansas, Kansas, New Mexico, and Hawaii Residents

The UMKC School of Dentistry has agreements for residents of these states. A select number of certified residents receive a waiver of the full non-resident fee differential on an annual basis.
